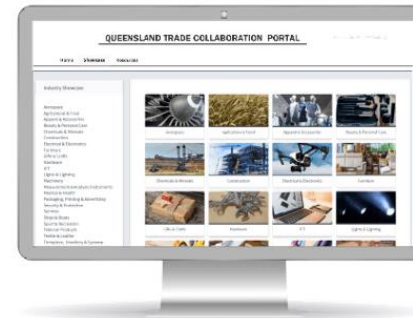

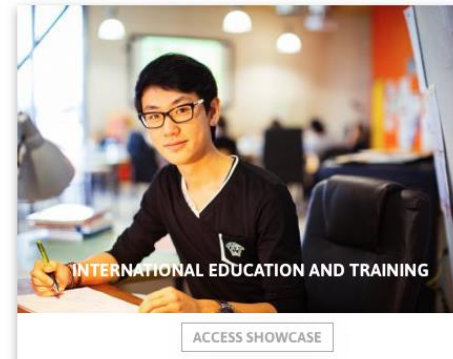
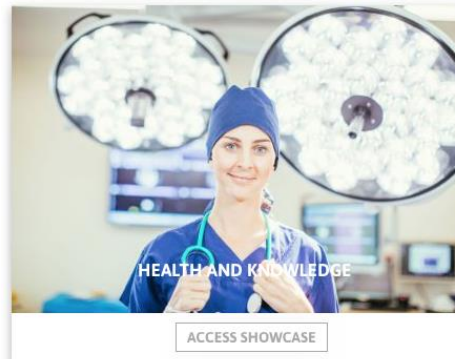
VIEW SHOWCASE

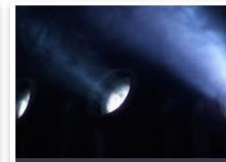

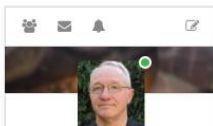

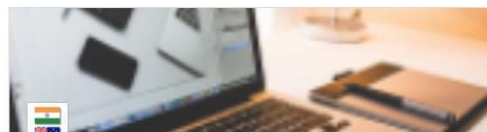
